

Key lessons from Sam:



HOLISTIC TREATMENT

Treat the whole child not just the symptoms. Sam says: "I am Sam. I am not just the sum total of my symptoms. I AM SAM!"



WE ARE HUMAN

A child is a person, a human first and foremost and so are you. Always offer hope and always respect the child and family's dignity.



FAMILY SUPPORT (NOT DIFFICULT JUST SCARED HAVING LANDED ABRUPTLY ON MARS)

Chronic illness impacts on the whole family. How are they coping? Are they supported? Are they empowered? Have you allowed their voice to be heard?

EXCELLENCE OF CARE

As a doctor and a health professional, work as a team. An integrated multi-disciplinary team caring for a patient holistically = excellence of care.



IT IS HUMAN TO ERR

Health professionals can be wrong and can say that they do not know. This is not failure. This is being human and we applaud you. It is human to err.



SAY YOU'RE SORRY

IT IS OKAY to say you are sorry. In this way you will save families from much guilt, grief and heartbreak. In fact saying you are sorry may even be the simple answer to many medical-legal woes.

SECOND OPINIONS

Families are entitled to a second opinion. Do not take it personally.

ALWAYS do what is best for the child and family. Empathetic healthcare and egos do not mix well, so rather try and leave egos out of healthcare all together.

QUESTIONS

Questions from families are just questions. They are not being "difficult". They do not, not trust you. They are simply scared and seeking answers. Mutual respect and good communication is key. "Never stop listening and learning" says Sam...



LIFE BEYOND RESTRICTIONS

Sam never went outside other than when being transferred between hospitals. Children must be allowed to play, to breathe fresh air to LIVE despite their restrictions. ICU is not a home for children. Seek ways to let a child be a child!



TRANSITION HOME

Get a child home as soon as possible. We have compiled a Parent's Survival Guide for ICU to ensure that parents are better equipped and supported when facing the scary roller coaster of months in hospital and the transition home.

SUPPORT THROUGHOUT A LIFETIME

When a complex illness is recognised, (since diagnosis can take months or even years with some children remaining undiagnosed), bring in a holistic team approach, as provided by a Palliative Care Team. Paediatric Palliative Care (PPC) is about supporting quality of life throughout a child's lifetime, which can be many years. Let's bust the myth that PPC is just for end of life care, since this could not be further from the truth. PPC is about supporting paediatric patients to live WELL and so must happen on recognition of a chronic illness and not left until a child is critical and dying.
